

## OLDHAM COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION POLICY

### ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

6013

*Relates to: 6013AR*

The Board shall, in relation to each school under its jurisdiction, provide and maintain a physical environment that is conducive to the health and safety of school children. It shall be the responsibility of the Board to comply with current laws and regulations applicable to all public buildings pertinent to health, sanitation and safety. In accordance with current regulations and standards, it shall be the responsibility of the Board to:

- a) Provide an adequate supply of water of safe, potable, sanitary quality.
- b) Provide a sanitary disposal of sewage, other water carried waste, and solid waste.
- c) Provide adequate toilet and lavatory facilities and other sanitary fixtures according to the State Plumbing Code.
- d) Provide adequate heating, lighting and ventilation in all school buildings.
- e) Provide adequate facilities and equipment for cafeterias and lunchrooms as required by the State Food Service Code.
- f) Supervise the general sanitation and safety of the school buildings, grounds and playground equipment.
- g) Provide adequate first-aid facilities.
- h) Maintain compliance with all environmental protection agency regulations and guidelines.
