Topic	Statement
A. Assignments	<p>In addition to nightly reading, all students of La Grange Elementary School will spend an additional 15-30 minutes on content-area homework.</p> <p>All assignments will be collected on day due as determined by the grade level teams. Families will be notified of each grade level homework expectation at the beginning of the school year.</p>
B. Consequences	<p>Incentives for homework completion is the participation in Fun Friday events. Make-up of missed homework assignments will be up to the individual teacher based on the particular child's needs.</p>
C. Homework Activities	<p>Homework should be an extension of the activities in school. They should be a review and/or an assignment that the student is able to complete independently.</p> <p>Suggestions for homework include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">K: ABC Chart, Sight Words1: Spiral Math & Word Work3: Math Review4: Simple Solutions & Weekly Reading Reflection5: Extension of the activities in school.
D. Parent Orientation	<p>The homework policy shall be sent home in the fall of the year, within the first two weeks of school.</p>
